WHAT'S OUR PLAN

Pediatric Care Africa's main focus is on children between 0-18 years of age.

We have a number of active programs:

- (1) 1000 surgeries for 1000 children.
- (2) Provision of 350 baby care packs to 350 children requiring food, milk, nappies etc.
- (3) Ensuring medical access to private Doctors and Specialists to +600 children over the next 2 years.
- (4) To deliver 90 000 kg of food relating to over 300 000 meals to families effected by Covid-19 lockdown.

Our strategy over the following 2 years will be to recover from the tremendous financial cost to us, due to the Covid-19 pandemic and grow our services.

The Covid-19 pandemic hit hard and all our funds have gone into feeding programs, we would like to build on our funds in order to make much needed surgeries happen.

Raising awareness for our cause is also very important and we hope to build a national & international presence in the next 2 years.

Details STRATEGY & CURRENT SITUATION

STRATEGY

Over the next two years we would like to build on our current relationships as well as build new partnerships with like minded businesses & organizations.

Stichting Support Pediatric care Africa is founded in The Netherlands to support Pediatric care Africa in raising funds to reach their objectives.

It is imperative for us, to establish a constant, predictable flow of income in order to plan surgeries & medical treatments in advance, and prepare for the next natural disaster/pandemic.

In order for us to obtain our objectives we need to raise awareness for our cause and objectives.

Our goal is to gain much bigger support nationally & internationally through our social media platforms, regular appearances on local radio stations & newspapers as well as national platforms.

As part of our strategy to generate funds we will be arranging and hosting a number of sporting and cultural events yearly.

CURRENT SITUATION

With the current Covid19 pandemic we have been inundated with requests for food assistance from desperate communities and we currently supply food parcels to 500 families every 2 weeks.

This has put a huge strain on our available funds, with the result that we are not able to fund surgeries at this time.

We will continue to assist with food parcels until we reach level 1 of lock down.

At this time, fundraising has become more and more difficult due to lock down and restrictions in South Africa.

Many of our regular donors are struggling and are not able to offer assistance at this time.

We are also not able to host any of our planned fundraising events as this does not adhere to social distancing protocols.

It is of utmost importance to get financial assistance in order to keep assisting people with no other food source.



PLANNED ACTIVITIES

Fundraising events are one of our biggest forms of income and thus we have planned the following for 2021 & 2022:

- Gala Event & Auction with Busamed Lowveld Private Hospital.

- Food Donation drives at local schools.

Other forms of public fundraising planned:

- Durban Ironman Event with PCA team
- Be a Hero Running Event with local clubs
- Fundraising stands at local festivals
- Fundraisers in The Netherlands
- Apply for funds and grants in The Netherlands
- Start a club "Friends of Pediatric care Africa" in The Netherlands as well in South Africa.

One of our big annual events are: "Ride for a Child" - Dr. André Hattingh and his support team traveling around South Africa (6867km) on a motorbike to raise funds and awareness for children's surgeries.

FUNDRAISING IDEAS

In the coming two years we are on a mission to partner with businesses that has the same passion for making a difference as we have.

We are also constantly building new relationships with donors and keeping them in the loop as to what we do with the funds they donate to our cause.

We would like to establish an ongoing relationship with suppliers that are willing to donate towards our monthly nutritional program.

With regards to social distancing and keeping our donors safe we are looking into alternative ways of fundraising; online auctions, online events, social distance fun runs etc.

- 330+ Private GP appointments per year.
- 180+ Therapy Sessions & Specialist Doctors visits per year.
- 500 Nutritional Food Parcels to babies and toddlers on a monthly basis.
- High level disaster response capability.

CONTINIOUS FUNDING

- R 300 000.00 per month on food (includes goods donations).
- R 500 000 per month for surgeries
 & medical care.
- R 120 000.00 per month on operating costs
